Fond du Lac Amateur Radio Club will not be able to hold monthly club meetings at Moraine Park Technical College through September, 2020. I received an email from the Facilities and Building Dept. yesterday



stating that MPTC will not be opening their facilities to community groups through Sept., 2020. All room reservations will be canceled through September. It appears we will be holding our club meetings

The Fond du Lac Amateur Radio Club had to change our plans for ARRIL Field Day 2020 due to the Coronavirus Pandemic. We couldn't use the UW-FDL north parking lot since the campus is closed and it would be difficult to practice social distancing the way we normally hold Field Day. One of the suggestions that the ARRL came up with for Field Day 2020 was have all club members operate the event from their home stations. This would change our entry class from 2A which is for two HF stations operating with emergency power to a 1D class for home stations running off commercial power. If you're operating from home using a battery or generator powering your HF station the class is 1E. Since the ARRL waived the rules for 2020 for Class D stations who now can work class A, B, C, D, E, and F stations for Field Day. Class E stations can work class A, B, C, D, E and F stations which doesn't change in 2020.

# Article on ARRL Field Day 2020

Field Day station exchange is: 1D WI or 1E WI. Stations can be worked once per band per mode. HF bands that can be used are 160 meters, 80 meters, 40 meters, 20 meters, 15 meters and 10 meters. None of the WARC bands can be used for Field Day. VHF/UHF bands can be used as well but repeaters can't be used for Field Day contacts. Scoring works as follows: Phone contacts count 1 point, CW and digital contacts count 2 points. There is a power multiplier which is determined by the highest power output you are using at your home station. If you are running under 150 watts it is 1.5. Check the rules for other power outputs at the ARRL website.

For 2020 Field Day an aggregate club score will published with 2020 results in QST which will be the sum of individual club participants any class who sent their entry in to the ARRL. If you want the complete 2020 Field Day rules go to: http://www. Arrl.org/field day website. There is a complete Field Day packet at the ARRL website you can get entry forms, Field Day logs and other forms you might need for operating Field. The ARRL Field Day entries have to postmarked by July 28, 2020.

If you're going to do your Field Day logging via computer, I would recommend the N3FJP Field Day Logging software which the club has used for a number of years. It is easy to use and works well The ARRL will be contacting all Field Day Logging software developers of the waiver changes for 2020 so hopefully they can make the changes before Field Day weekend. I would encourage all club members to participate in 2020 ARRL Field Day. It is great practice in contesting as well as preparing for an emergency.
