

Minutes of Fond du Lac Amateur Radio Club Meeting August 24, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 7:01pm by President Bob Burrier N2TSQ. Members introduced themselves. A moment of silence was observed for Silent Key David Witt WD9W. A presentation was given on FTC RF Exposure Rules was given by Dr. Greg Lapin N9GL.

A motion was made by Wendy Kudrowicz to approve the minutes of the July meeting and seconded by Paul Tvurdy N9KLK. The motion passed by unanimous voice vote. The Treasurer's report was given by Doug Schultz N9EZF. A motion was made by Justin Buell KB9YET and seconded by Phil Schmahl W9MW to approve the report and payment of bills. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote. It was noted that Tim Braun W9AAV was not able to be present and his discussion of the web site was postponed to the next meeting. Phil reported that a program for the Boy Scouts merit badge will be presented at a date to be announced and that any Club members interested in helping should contact him.

Bob reported that the future of the Club was discussed at the recent Board meeting and a survey has been developed for input by Club members. The survey will be sent by e-mail soon and members are encouraged to give their input openly. The Board meeting discussion included the possibility for the trailer being improved by addition of a second station desk. A battery and several storage tubs currently used are property of Justin and will need to be replaced by the Club. Gene Peterson KD9IAG expressed concern for the trailer being overloaded with equipment. The trailer committee will review this concern and make recommendations. Another issue from the Board meeting was the possibility of investing Club funds to earn more interest. Joe Scheibinger K9VY mentioned a money market fund by Charles Schwab agency that earns currently 5.4% with no early withdrawal penalty. A motion was made by Tom Powell Kc9VXR and seconded by Phil to authorize the opening of a money market account in the amount of \$7000 in the name of the Club as a 501.c3 with the club Treasurer as primary signatory and the President as secondary. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote.


